UNLOAD FIREARM BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION! FAILURE TO DO SO MAY LEAD TO SERIOUS INJURY OR DEATH! PLACE FIREARM SAFETY ON. REMOVE MAGAZINE AND CYCLE BOLT TO REMOVE ANY ROUND FROM THE CHAMBER. VISUALLY INSPECT CHAMBER TO MAKE SURE IT IS EMPTY BEFORE PROCEEDING.

NOTE: Installation of this part involves modification to your firearm. If you are not comfortable performing this work, seek a competent gunsmith. Read all instructions before beginning installation.

Tools you will need: Bench vice, upper receiver vice block, hammer, punch set, barrel nut removal tool, torque wrench, and strap wrench.

Step 1: Make sure rifle is unloaded.

Step 2: Remove upper from lower.

Step 3: Remove upper and lower half of standard hand guard.

***Note:** These parts will not be reused.

Step 4: Using punch and hammer drive out taper pins from left to right, and remove front site post and gas tube assembly, and hand guard front cap.

Step 5: Using a proper vice block, mount upper receiver into vice and remove barrel nut with barrel nut wrench.

***Note:** Original barrel nut assembly, which includes delta ring, and original handguard front cap, will not be reused.

Step 6: Install M4 barrel nut with threaded ring behind it. Torque to 32 Foot Pounds and tighten until gas tube hole is aligned with gas tube hole on upper receiver.

Step 7: Install alignment pins into barrel nut. Slide hand guard over barrel. Screw on threaded ring which will draw hand guard into barrel nut and lock hand guard into the indexing pins.

***Note:** On some models, specifically the 12.0 FSP, it will be necessary to slide the front site post and gas tube assembly on along with hand guard. In order to slide these on together the gas tube will have to be removed by using hammer and punch and reinstalled accordingly inside the hand guard.

Step 8: Tighten threaded ring with strap wrench.

Step 9: Reinstall front site post and gas tube assembly and taper pins, (using punch and hammer).
